



Proclamation of Tartan Day

April 6, 1993

A resolution to proclaim April 6 as **Tartan Day** was presented in the Legislative Assembly of New Brunswick on December 11, 1992. Introduced and moved by **Georgie Day**, MLA for Kings Centre and seconded by **Stuart Jamieson**, MLA for Saint John Fundy, it was passed by unanimous consent. The official proclamation was made by **Hon. Frank McKenna**, Premier of New Brunswick, on April 6, 1993.

Scottish immigrants and their descendants have played, and will continue to play, a major role in the development of the Canadian and New Brunswick identity. Therefore, it is with a great deal of pleasure that I declare today, April 6, and every April 6 thereafter, as **Tartan Day** in New Brunswick.
